Project Updates:

HIPAA

- Code Set Status
 - HIPAA Alert #4 is going out with changes to T1011 to H0047, UK modifier codes for MH in EDI guidelines.
 - W. Hull and J. Hughes have written the MDS set guidelines and should be posted soon.

Test Files (ANSI 837 4010)

- Accepting in formally – showing creation side of vendors and providers. Finishing the touches on the formal procedures for 3/13/03.

EDI Documentation

- Version control.

Board Responsibilities for new build of Diamond 8+

- The State will provide spreadsheets and other supporting files/reports to assist in this process. We are requesting that each board or consortium assign a main contact person and a backup contact person who will receive these communications. They will be responsible for completing the requests (or distributing, collecting, and reviewing if other board staff input is required) and then forwarding the updated information back to the State. See attachment for complete handout.

Users Group Updates:

- **Members** – Basically starting a new environment. See John Raab's status attached report. Board would continue to add new members with span in new environment. All adds will be done in new environment by the boards. The current system will be available for around 13 months for services (with spans). The discussion regarding member had to do whether boards would or would not have access to make changes to the current environment once the HIPAA environment was up and running. There was discussion about the option and it was specified that new members MUST be added in new environment only. Only members of the member maintenance group could add members in the old environment and that would be done using extracts of members from the new environment that had spans prior to 07/01/2003. If members were added in the old environment by anyone other than the Member Maintenance Group, the records would be deleted without notification. In addition, those users that were responsible for adding the members would be notified that they would lose their access to the old environment if they didn't cease adding members in the old environment. This was an option that had significant support from the boards but needed to be discussed in detail by the MACSIS Operations Management group before a decision could be shared. The decision was tabled pending further discussion in MOM.
- **Claims** – Kim McCloskey reported that they hope to schedule a Claims Users Group meeting within the next month or so.
- **BH Focus** – AOD providers reporting 59 out of 94, Dual (AODMH) providers reporting 123 out of 191 and MH providers reporting 87 out of 296. Joe Wiant reported that there is serious consideration not to send in BH data from Mental Health. It is not mandated. Walter Hull mad a comment that the response to this is located on the AOD website www.ada.state.oh.us. The next BH Focus meeting will be on March 13th from 9-10:30am on the bridge line (614) 644-1098.
- **MIS** – There is a MIS User Group meeting on March 13th at the Dept. of Commerce, 6606 Tussing Road, Reynoldsburg starting around 10am. The topics to be covered are dual systems, review 837/835 compliance and Diamond 8+ system.
- **Finance** –

Global Issues :

- DIP codes – send Walter Hull email about being a member of this committee. We need assistance in establishing how DIPs would participate in MACSIS. Don't need help on the codes.
- HIPAA FAQs – is addressed in the HIPAA Alert #4. The supplemental materials and PowerPoint presentations from the EDI conferences to be posted in version 1.0 is being finalized.

- Modifier 047 code – average unit rate (MACSIS) has not been developed.
- Diagnostic Code (Physician & Non Physician) – allocated cost for one or another (bill separately). Currently billed as med-somatic.
