Project Updates

- HIPAA
 - EDI Subgroup meeting today from 1-3pm.
 - Documentation
 - Updated ODADAS and ODMH Procedure Code, Modifier and Medical Definitions Matrix to include the non-payable MEDEF's
 - The MACSIS HIPAA Claim Correction Procedure has been updated to reflect the change in the OHEXT error report, which no longer has the negative or zero net amount error.
 - Emails have been sent out regarding the new listserve
 - The new Claims Section of the Board Operations Manual has been completed and is in draft form. It is currently being reviewed by State staff. The format will allow it to be placed in a 3-hole binder and pages can be updated/replaced as necessary
 - Departments are giving the Board Association a 270/271 grant for software and possibility to follow same procedure for the 277/276.
 - Upgrade – in early stages of 8.3.1.b version.
 - Largely transparent
 - Testing
 - 300 providers approved thru Tier 2
 - 200 providers live on HIPAA
 - Reasonable amount of agencies have not attempted Tier 1. Will see reports regarding providers having problems.
 - ODADAS may not ask for medically assisted treatment code – may keep the methadone code as is.

- Claims
 - User group meeting investigating 831 – at least one month away.
- BH Module
 - BH data up to the 40% mark.
 - All ODADAS boards must send in BH claims.
 - ODADAS will put MH/BH data in bucket; no reports will be done by ODADAS.
- MIS
 - User group meeting on Oct. 16th at the Franklin County ADAMH Board.
 - Reminder – Archiving FY'02 data out of MHPROD on Columbus Day Weekend.
- Finance

- Board Global Issues
 - Medicaid provider (cash flow problem) – talk to Area Director.

- ODJFS has issued Medicaid PIN numbers for those mental health agencies that completed their ODJFS provider application that is a part of their community Medicaid agreements and has included a Medicare number so that they may receive Medicare/Medicaid crossover reimbursement for the coinsurance and deductible. The Medicaid PIN numbers were mailed directly to the Providers/Agencies.
