2. Email Provider Modification Request Forms to Debbie Downs .	MACSIS Provider Request Form	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Required for any provider who has sent in their NPI information, is closing a agency or consolidating agencies. • Do not fax electronic versions of the Provider Modification Request Forms.
3. Determine if the provider should submit a Tier 1 or Tier 2 Test File.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Guidelines Pertaining to MACSIS – Topic 41B – EDI Testing Policy • Procedure for Submitting EDI Test Files 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If it is the vendor's first NPI-format file submission for a product or version of software, they are strongly encouraged to submit a Tier 1 file first to rule out any syntax or structural problems. • If the provider has added a new subpart, changed software or installed a major upgrade, Tier 1 testing is required. • If the provider fails basic syntax/structure edits for Tier 2, they will be asked to submit a Tier 1 file.
4. Receive Tier 1 Test file from provider. 6. Complete MACSIS EDI Claims Testing Request Form and email to macsistesting@mh.state.oh.us .	♦ MACSIS EDI Claims Testing Request Form	Self-explanatory
7. Communicate results of test with provider as soon as possible	n/a	It is very important that you respond to the provider with the results of the test on a timely basis.
8. Obtain Tier 2 Test file from provider. 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		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For new agencies, verify that a minimum of 10 claims per procedure/modifier code combination for all contracted services is included on the file. • Verify that all lines of business (Medicaid and Non) are represented in the file • Verify that an “other payer” scenario is included for both Medicaid and Non-Medicaid eligible services if the provider bills other insurance • Verify that same day services are summed/rolled if included on the file. • Tier 2 test files should not be larger than 500 claims
9. FTP test file to /county/(board code)/hipaa/tier2test	♦ n/a	Self-explanatory
10. Complete MACSIS EDI Claims Testing Request Form and HIPAA Service Rate Forms and email to macsistesting@mh.state.oh.us .	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • MACSIS EDI Claims Testing Request Form • HIPAA Service Rate Form - ODMH • HIPAA Service Rate Form - ODADAS 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Verify the HIPAA Service Rate Forms agree with the expected rates in Diamond. • If the provider fails basic syntax and structure compliance during Tier 2, they will be asked to submit a Tier 1 file.
11. Continue to test until the provider has passed Tier 2.	n/a	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Once approved for Tier 2 NPI claim file submission, providers may begin submitting NPI claim files but should remember to use the production file naming convention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ For production NPI files, the file name should begin with “N” (ex. N0010431.31406) ○ Several providers have submitted NPI-format claim files using the wrong naming convention. Please be careful to remember: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ NPI production files begin with “N”

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		<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ NPI test files begin with "X"◆ A "clean" cutover to NPI is recommended; Sending dual formats presents problems.
